



The MCSPCA understands the concerns about COVID-19 and we continue to take measures to keep pets & people safe within our community. All three of our shelters have remained closed to public access since the start of this health crisis. Staff are on-site providing the best care possible to the animals within our shelters every day and we have staff available by phone at each of our locations to answer any questions that you may have.

All lost animals will be posted on our website, checked for ID, scanned for a microchip, and cross-checked with our lost reports. If/when an owner is located we will make arrangements for the owner to pick up their pet as soon as feasibly possible.

It is also essential that we continue to search for homes for the animals in our care during this crisis and we will continue to operate under the following modifications.

All animal adoptions will be by **APPOINTMENT ONLY** with an approved application and the following additional guidelines in effect.

- Animals may be viewed on our website, which is updated hourly. Additional information may be obtained by calling the facility housing the pet, clicking the links on our website, or by viewing our Facebook page which continues to be updated with adoptable pets.

- If you find an animal in which you are interested, you must submit an adoption application for that animal via email **as an attachment** (best done on a tablet, laptop, or desktop) or by fax.
 - Applications must include the specific animal ID information.
 - Be submitted to the appropriate facility (see below.)
 - Applications are available at www.montgomerycountyspca.org/Info/Application.pdf
- Incomplete applications, application missing answers, or missing pertinent information will not be considered. Please be sure that all application questions are answered prior to submission.
- Once the application has been reviewed and approved, a staff member will be in contact to schedule an appointment so you can meet with the animal.
 - Please be aware that we can only select one applicant for an animal and encourage you to reapply for another animal if your application was not selected for a particular pet.
